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## Dependence: An Affective Definition

"The notion of dependence on a drug, object, role, activity or any other stimulus-source requires the crucial feature of negative affect experienced in its absence. The degree of dependence can be equated with the amount of this negative affect, which may range from mild discomfort to extreme distress, or it may be equated with the amount of difficulty or effort required to do without the drug, object, etc."

- Norepinephrine/Epinephrine-
- stimulant,anger,fear,anxiety,fight,flight
- Serotonin-depressant,sleep,calm,pleasure
- GABA-relaxant, stress reduction, seizure threshold
- Endorphins-pain relief, pleasure
- Acetylcholine-involutary actions,memory,motivation
- Anandamide-memory,new learning,calmness
- Glutamate-organization of brain signaling, memory, pain
- Dopamine-perception,movement,pleasure
- PIP- loving of one's self,others,GOD

- Positive Family History
- Passed from mother/ father to son/ daughter
- 12-15 years drinking before treatment
- 70% AA
