What is ECCO?

ECCO is a web-based program with features designed to work together to enhance the way systems educate through training and the dissemination of knowledge, support providers through Technical Assistance (TA) and coaching, tracks progress and captures data.

The ECCO system has custom-built tools for:

- Educating at the community-level process
- Supporting the prevention process
- Tracking strategy implementation and progress
